Reliance on EMRs for code selection is dangerous, failure to code to the highest degree of specificity harms reimbursement and utilization statistics. Make sure documentation supports the 2023 updates.

Significant changes in the External Cause of Morbidity codes, Injury Poisoning, and Other Consequences of External Causes; new Z codes focused on Social Determinants of Health, neurology/mental health dementia codes, cardiology, and OB codes; 139 new codes in Chapter 14 Diseases of the Genitourinary System; many new endometriosis codes by site and now depth (N80-)

Medical coders, billers, providers, managers, consultants, and compliance officers are encouraged to attend to learn about the potential impact to your claims and save time by helping you identify any templates or other documents that may need to be updated and/or replaced.
