## Enforcement of Information Blocking is Coming... Are You Ready for April 5?

ONC has finalized the Cures Act Final Rule attempting to clarify what is – and is not – “information blocking.” These Information Blocking (IB) rules apply to various groups and compliance is expected by April 5, 2021. Learn key details on what these rules could mean for you, particularly with respect to facilitating patient access to their health information.
