#### What's New

This course and exam are updated annually using current American Medical Association (AMA) published versions of the CPT®, HCPCS, and ICD-10-CM coding manuals. General coding and chapter-specific guidelines are updated with explanations and guidance for proper use, including E/M code and documentation changes.

# **What's Required**

Self-supplied CPT®, HCPCS, ICD-10-CM code set manuals and a medical dictionary are required throughout the course and on the exam day. Current 2022 code set manuals are highly recommended for accurate code selection.

## What's Included

Candidates are advised to take PMI's free online 20-question assessment to measure baseline knowledge: <a href="mailto:pmiMD.com/areyouready">pmiMD.com/areyouready</a>
Registrants with limited outpatient medical coding experience should complete the *Principles of Coding* supplemental training course, included with enrollment, before beginning the CMC course.

This instructor-led course includes a binder of learning materials, workbook exercises, a practice exam, and timed, proctored certification exam. A score of 70% or better is required. If a passing grade is not achieved on the first attempt, candidates may re-test for an additional fee.

Having a Certified Medical Coder in the office who is on top of these changes helps to keep the office in compliance and the money coming into the office. I like to look at the average days in AR for a provider's claims. If claims are not being paid, it is often due to inaccurate coding.
