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Medicare & Compliance Changes 2022

The proposed Medicare Physician Fee Schedule rule for 2022 includes another decrease in the conversion factor. The past sequester and the PAYGO rule will also have an impact. Providers could be facing up to 9 percent in payment cuts next year unless Congress intervenes. Nearly all medical practices that bill Medicare should expect to feel the squeeze next year. Take a guided tour of these and other changes for 2022 that will directly impact provider reimbursement and/or healthcare compliance in the new year. Significant changes have been proposed for shared services and critical care and 99291 reporting requirements. Expect additions to the MIPS eligible clinicians list for 2022.
